Fact 1: Most citizens know someone with a disability


70% know someone with a disability




Fact 1: The most common cause is the "plan of God"








Fact 3: Almost half of Tanzanians are aware of discrimination against people with disability




Fact 4: One out of three citizens are aware of children with disabilities not attending school

Fact 5: One out of eight citizens has heard on albinos in their community


