




Over the past year, how often have you felt unsafe walking in your neighbouhood?

Over the past year, how often have you felt unsafe walking in your neighbourhood?




When was the last time you had something stolen from you?










#### Incidence of threats, beatings and stoning perpetrated by different groups in the past year








#### How likely do you think it is that the following groups will be punished according to the law for committing a crime?

#### What do you think is the main reason that people do not report crimes to the police?




